



## Educating parents on school app

NEW mobile payment technology QkR will change the way many parents pay for their child's education.

The app enables parents to provide increased control over cash flow and save them time by ordering meals, contribute to fundraising and pay for school items at their convenience.

An initiative launched by Commonwealth Bank and Mastercard, Australian schools are the first in the world to have access to the technology.

"Throughout the pilot in Victoria, we've seen QkR reduce financial admin and improve the management and planning of volunteer hours," Commonwealth Bank's Nick Aronson said.
